

Minot City Hall Rehabilitation Project Open House Event Summary

City Project 4466

The City of Minot and JLG Architects held an open house event on July 22, 2021 located at City Hall Council Chambers from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Members of the public were invited to view presentation boards (attached to this report) produced by JLG and ask any questions about the project. There was not a formal presentation of data.

Approximately 10 citizens stopped by the event at various times through the night.

Only a few questions were asked by the public. The questions and responses are listed below:

Q: What is the construction cost of the project?

A: Approximately \$7.5M

Q: Will there be public ADA restrooms available?

A: Yes, a set of male and female restroom will be available on all three floors.

Q: How much parking will be available?

A: The property has approximately 52 spaces. The adjacent parking ramp has approximately 200 spaces.

Q: When will the project go out for bid?

A: Fall of 2021

Q: We lease space from the City currently. Will you continue to lease parking spaces to us?

A: We will negotiate leased parking in any agreement we have with you.

No members of the public came after 7:20 pm. Staff and JLG remained available until 8:00 pm at which time we concluded the event.

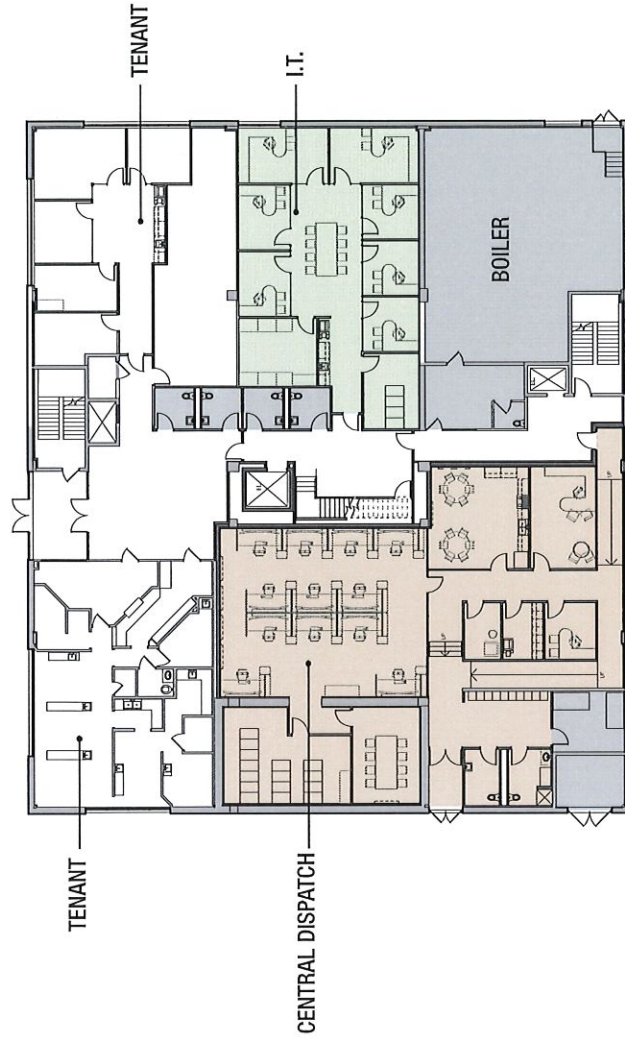

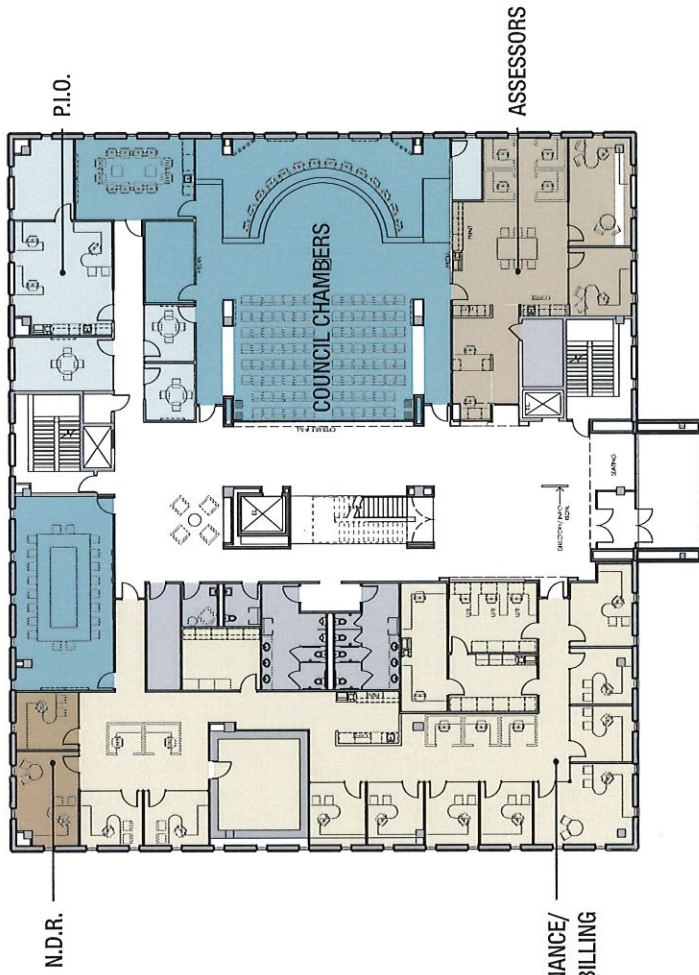

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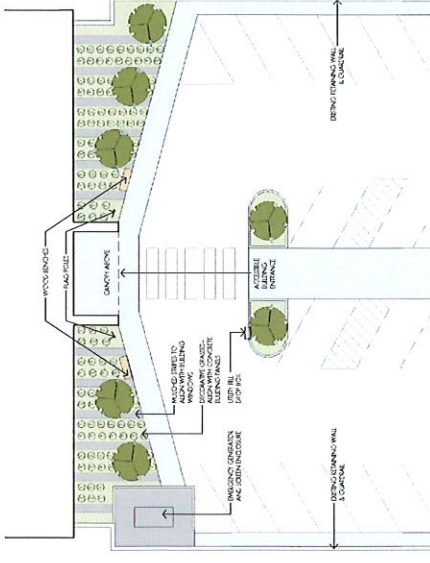
