


Yard Waste Collection Sites



RECYCLING PROGRAM WITH THE BLUE LID

- The City of Minot has ALL in ONE recycling which allows residents to deposit all of their recycling in ONE BIN. It's never BIN easier!
- Recyclables will be picked up every other week on Mon or Tues according to your regular scheduled route, in the event of a holiday the collection will happen on Wednesday (check the city website for make-up days).
- Recyclables can be dropped off at the Landfill (see Landfill Fees).

Do

- ✓ Recycle plastics #1, 2, & 5
- ✓ Empty all food / beverage content - rinse container
- ✓ Keep items loose in the bin
- ✓ Make sure the cart lid is closed all the way

Don't

- ✗ Recycle plastics #3, 4, 6, & 7 or shredded paper
- ✗ Recycle yard waste / organics
- ✗ Recycle plastic bags or glass
- ✗ Recycle electronics or hazardous materials
- ✗ Bag recyclables

WASTE COLLECTION ROUTES AND SCHEDULE

The City of Minot will provide automated collection twice per week. Recycling is picked up every other week, and garbage is picked up twice per week, except on recycling week.

SCHEDULED HOLIDAYS

Materials will **NOT** be collected on the following holidays. If the holiday falls on your normal collection day, the City will collect materials the next regularly scheduled collection day. Holidays are made up on Wednesday for recycling pick up. Certain holidays are made up for garbage to ensure a minimum of once per week collection. See make-up days on the city website.

RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION FEES

The waste collection fees include the cost of collection of all residential waste and the cost of burying the waste in the City of Minot Landfill. Fees are based on the current operating budget and are adjusted periodically to reflect the cost of service.

- The monthly charge per resident will depend on the size of cart residents choose, and will be included on each residential water bill.

- ✓ 35-gallon service is \$15.00
- ✓ 65-gallon service is \$17.50
- ✓ 95-gallon service is \$20.00
- ✓ Recycling service is \$2.60

- Residents with higher volumes of waste or recyclables can upgrade to a bigger cart or ask for additional carts, with an added monthly fee being the same as the prices above.
- Once per calendar year residents will be allowed to swap their cart for another size for free.
- There will be a \$30.00 fee assessed for each additional swap thereafter.

COLLECTION LOCATIONS

• STREET COLLECTION

All carts must be placed on the curb or pavement edge. Waste collection carts may not be placed for collection prior to 6:00 pm the day before collection. Carts must be removed from the collection point before 10:00 pm the day of collection.

- ✓ Waste carts must not be placed within three (3) feet of objects such as garages, fences, cars, telephone poles and other waste carts.

• ALLEY COLLECTION

- ✓ Waste carts must be placed three (3) feet from all objects (garages, fences, cars, telephone poles and other waste/recycling carts, etc.) and within three (3) feet from alley to where access is not impeded by obstructions (garage/fence).

• WINTER COLLECTION •

During winter and heavy snow conditions waste collection carts must be placed on the corner of the driveway, free of vehicles, 3 feet on either side of a snow berm, and other obstructions.

REGULATIONS FOR CITY ISSUED WASTE COLLECTION CARTS

- All waste must fit in the cart, with the lid closed.
- Do not write on the carts with spray paint or permanent marker.
- These carts must remain at the property if the property is sold.
- **The carts must be set out by 7:00 AM on collection day.**
- Place carts on the curb at the end of the driveway or sidewalk at least 3 feet from other items such as parked cars, power lines, hydrants, mailboxes, etc.
- Trucks WILL NOT be rerouted for late placements.
- Waste must be placed in bags before placed into the container.
- Waste should not be "PACKED" into the carts. The contents must fall freely when the cart is dumped.
- City issued carts must be free of snow and ice.
- The handle of the carts must face the house.
- Animal waste must be placed in a plastic bag before being placed in the carts.
- If your cart gets damaged by city collection crews, a new or repaired cart will be issued at no additional charge.
- All damage to the waste carts by the resident is the responsibility of the resident to replace.
- It is the responsibility of each homeowner to keep the cart clean.

PROHIBITED ITEMS IN WASTE CARTS

- Paint/Paint Cans and Stains
- Car Batteries/Lithium Batteries
- Tree Branches
- Ashes
- Concrete/Bricks
- Propane Tanks
- Motor Oil
- Grass Trimmings (Compost)
- Construction/Demo Debris
- Tires
- Dirt/Rocks
- Hazardous Waste

All of these items can be disposed of at the City of Minot Landfill.

SPRING & FALL CITY CLEANUP

- Refer to the cleanup week map for route schedules at [www.minotnd.gov](http://minotnd.gov).
- Spring cleanup is scheduled for April 28, 2025 – May 2, 2025.
- Fall cleanup is scheduled for Sep 8, 2025 – Sep 12, 2025.
- Set out waste before 7:00 AM on your scheduled cleanup day on the **boulevard only**. Any and all containers that are not garbage cans will be thrown away.
- Limit two appliances per household.
- The city will accept up to ten tires and propane tanks during cleanup events.
- E-Waste- televisions/computers shall not be set out for collection. The city will not accept paints, stains, oil, varnishes and other HHW items set out for collection.
- During cleanup week, with the proper photo I.D. and current City of Minot water bill, household quantities of waste will be accepted at the landfill free of charge.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION (HHW)

- The household hazardous waste drop off at the Landfill is open year-round.
- The facility will collect paints, stains, varnishes, solvents, oil, pesticides, herbicides and home cleaning products free of charge for city waste collection patrons only.
- E-waste is accepted at the spring HHW collection programs held at Public Works.
- The City of Minot will sponsor a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program at Public Works, the events will be open each day from 8 am - 5 pm.
- The HHW Collection Program event will take place May 2nd & 3rd.

YARD WASTE (COMPOST)

- The CITY DOES NOT collect yard waste with its collection crews.
- Residents can haul their compost to one of ten compost sites around town. See attached Map.
- Acceptable yard waste includes: grass, leaves, weeds, garden waste, apples, and sod.
- The City of Minot Landfill accepts yard waste (compost) for free!
- Do **NOT** mix yard waste with household waste.
- Compost sites are for city waste collection patrons ONLY.
- The compost sites are NOT to be used by non-residents, commercial haulers, or investment properties.
- Finished compost is given away free for residential use, contact the landfill for more details.

BRANCHES AND TREE TRIMMINGS

- Only trees and hedge trimmings cut by homeowner will be picked up, place them near your collection point.
- Branches must be cut and bundled in 6ft lengths.
- Tree branch piles will be collected by a separate truck throughout the week, as time permits.
- Logs must be no larger than 10" in diameter. Logs and Bundles must not exceed 40 lbs. in weight
- If the superintendent deems the tree pile to be excessive a roll-off will be provided for a fee of \$100 per dump.
- Trees cut by anyone other than the homeowner will NOT be hauled by the City.
- Christmas Trees – Residents can take their trees to compost sites 3 or 7. The sites will be open from Dec. 17 – Jan. 19.
- Do NOT place trees or tree branches in waste containers.
- Shredded wood mulch is given away free for residential use, contact landfill for more details.

VALET SERVICE

- The city will provide a valet service for elderly/handicapped residents that may have a medical issue that inhibits them from rolling their cart to the curb.
- In these rare cases, the driver will come up to the house to retrieve the waste cart, and return the cart to the house.
- Elderly/Handicapped residents can simply call Public Works 701-857-4140 to obtain an application. Return the application, signed by a doctor, to Public Works for review.
- Curb-side yard waste (compost) collection will only be provided to residents receiving the valet service.
- Valet service is required to be renewed annually.

BULK ITEM COLLECTION

Residents must call Public Works 701-857-4140 to schedule bulk collection. There is a \$15.00 fee for each bulk item collected at the curb. Bulk items are defined as:

- Couches
- End Tables
- Computer Desk
- Snow Blowers
- Appliances (washers, dryers, freezers, and stoves)

Building Materials and large debris piles are NOT considered a bulk item.

Moving? The city can provide a 20 yard roll-off for large debris piles for city garbage collection customers. There is a \$100.00 fee for each time the roll-off needs to be dumped. To schedule a roll-off call Public Works at 701-857-4140.

LANDFILL OPERATION

The City of Minot Landfill is located at 4450 37th Ave. SW. (2.5 miles west of Walmart)

All loads must be enclosed or covered with a tarp so the contents of the load stay within the transporting vehicle.

All waste loads are subject to random inspection. These inspections consist of unloading the vehicle and physically going through the contents of the load while the hauler waits until the inspection has been completed. All unacceptable waste shall be loaded back onto the transporting vehicle and remain in the possession of the hauler.

From July 7, 2025 – July 12, 2025 only, with the proper photo I.D. and current City of Minot Water Bill, household quantities of waste will be accepted at no charge. No contractors, no contractor vehicles/trailers, no dump body trucks.

LANDFILL FEES

- \$51.00/Ton Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) - \$10.00 Minimum Items such as: food, paper, cardboard, and plastic.
- \$37.00/Ton Inert Waste - \$5.00 Minimum Items such as: lumber, shingles, glass, and metal.
- \$15.00/Ton Trees - \$5.00 Minimum
- \$185.00/Ton Recycling - \$3.00 Minimum

LANDFILL PAYMENTS

Landfill payments can be made by cash, check, or credit/debit cards. The landfill has separate areas for trees, yard waste, appliances, tires, compost, inert waste, and household waste. The scale attendant will direct the customer to the proper disposal area.
